Wickham Park was dedicated in 1961 and is the former estate of Clarence and Edith Wickham. Originally 130 acres, the park was increased in size through a generous gift of 67 adjoining acres owned by Myrtle Williams. Other purchases and land exchanges have brought the park to its current size of approximately 250 acres.
